IX Vocational Competition for Handcrafted Log Home Builders

The Estonian Woodhouse Association is organizing for the 9th time on the **29th of June 2019** in Tallinn the **Vocational Competition for Handcrafted Log Home Builders**. The Competition takes place in [Estonian Open Air Museum](#).

The aim of the competition is to popularize the profession of a handcrafted log home builder.

During the competition the contestants will build different examples of log home corner types. Every contestant can choose between four different corner types: Estonian dovetail corner with wind-lock, Estonian square notch with wind-lock, Scandinavian notch and Saddle notch. Every contestant must fix a 1.5 m log to a prepared base – incl. building of one corner joint and 1.2 m long groove, and cut straight the log ends, following the lower logs. Judges will evaluate the building quality and speed.

Allowed tools: all hand tools and electric power tools, all other work equipment.

Safety equipment: all participants are required to use protective goggles, earphones (or ear plugs), gloves, safety boots, protective clothing (incl. long work trousers).

The prize fund: different Pro tools in value of 2500.- EUR
